### How to access the platform

#### **Getting Access - Leads**

- If you are a Health Board/Trust designated lead, we have made your account for you.
  - If you have not been active on the Epilepsy12 platform within the past year, we did not migrate your account to the new platform.
  - You can <u>reset your password</u> to gain access to your account.



#### Getting Access - Non-Leads <a href="https://e12.rcpch.ac.uk/">https://e12.rcpch.ac.uk/</a>

- If you are not a designated lead, your designated lead will need to make your account for you.
  - For more information, take a look at our <u>guidance</u>.
  - When your account is made, you will receive an email with a link to set your password. This link expires after 72 hours
  - If your link has expired, you can request a new link by <u>resetting your password</u>.



#### Logging in

- Access the platform here <a href="https://e12.rcpch.ac.uk/">https://e12.rcpch.ac.uk/</a>
- Click the sign-in button at the top right of the screen



- Enter your email, password, and complete the captcha.
- Enter your two factor authentication token. If it's your first time logging in, you will need to set up two factor authentication.



- You have two options when setting up two factor authentication
- 1. Email an email will be sent to you with a six digit code.
- 2. Authenticator app the app will provide a six digit code that refreshes every 30 seconds.



 To set up the authenticator app, follow the below guidance that appears on your screen. It will look like this:

#### Configure mobile app

Complete the following steps to configure your mobile app.

- 1. Install the Microsoft authenticator app for Windows Phone, Android or iOS.
- 2. In the app, add an account and choose "Work or school account".
- 3. Scan the image below.



Configure app without notifications

If you are unable to scan the image, enter the following information in your app.

If the app displays a six-digit code, you are done!
