We also have a robust clinical pipeline of investigational therapies across a range of modalities in other serious diseases where we have deep insight into causal human biology. At the end of 2023, this included acute and neuropathic pain, APOL1-mediated kidney disease (AMKD), type 1 diabetes (T1D), myotonic dystrophy type 1 (DM1) and alpha-1 antitrypsin deficiency (AATD). Our preclinical pipeline, which represents the next wave of innovation, is also broad, diverse and rapidly advancing.
