Parents & guardians know their children far better than we do. We **need to listen to them!**



Clear written & verbal safety netting is essential

Remember

if you think it is sepsis it's never the wrong thing to get help, to escalate, to manage as if it was because it's better to treat it than miss it.

How can we make the hospital experience easier for parents?



Take the time to simply explain what is going to happen: clear sign-posting can reassure and make it clear that a plan is in place.
