Q6 Please describe your current working pattern.



Q41 How often is the subject of climate change/sustainability discussed within your trust meetings?





Q43 Who can have the biggest positive influence on your experience of equality, diversity & inclusion? Rank from most influential (1) to least influential (7)





Q45 How important is it that the College continues to run its global programmes?




Q46 Are you interested in becoming more involved in global child health work?



Q48 How confident do you feel involving children and young people in helping to design, deliver or contribute to decisions about your services or areas of work?




Q51 How effective is the RCPCH website in connecting you with the College and enabling you to find the information you need?

Q52 Thinking about our main website www.rcpch.ac.uk, which content do you access regularly?


