

The Epilepsy12 clinical audit is exempt from the National Data Opt-Out

What is the National Data Opt-Out?

The National Data Opt-Out allows patients to opt out of their confidential patient information being used for research and planning. Epilepsy12 has been granted an exemption because applying the National Data Opt-Out to our audit would make our data less accurate and may impact the quality and safety of care that children and young people with epilepsy receive.

If you have opted out of sharing your data through the National Data Opt-Out, your data may still be shared with the Epilepsy12 audit.

What does Epilepsy12 do with my data?

The Epilepsy12 audit collects data from NHS trusts in England and Wales to improve the standard of care for children and young people with epilepsy. This information is used to highlight the successes of services and identify areas for improvement.

What if I don't want my information to be collected for Epilepsy12?

You can still choose to withdraw your data from the audit. You can inform your clinical team of your choice or you can email the audit team directly at epilepsy12@rcpch.ac.uk.
