The third year will be structured based on the trainee's individual learning and developmental needs.  The programme provides excellent all-round experience in all aspects of paediatric nephrology including transplantation, dialysis (HD, PD and Home HD), renal metabolic disease (one of the designated national cystinosis centres) and hypertension.  The trainee will have opportunities to participate in QI projects and also supported to undertake clinical research during their training period.
