Deanery	Post title	Hospital/centre	Places available	Additional information
East of England	Oncology East of England - Cambridge	Addenbrookes Hospital, Cambridge (18 months - Oncology) & (6 months - Bone Marrow Transplant)	1	This is a 2-year rotation at Addenbrooke's Hospital, Cambridge, and includes BMT placement at Cambridge. The order of rotation may vary.
London	Oncology London - Camden	Great Ormond Street Hospital (12 months) University College Hospital (12 months)	2	Rotations will start at either Great Ormond Street Hospital (GOSH) or University College Hospital for 12 months (WTE) and then rotate to another training centre, including Royal Marden hospital (depending on availability and training requirements). All trainees must rotate to a BMT centre (GOSH or Royal Marsden). Programmes usually 24 months in duration but if trainees are appointed at ST5/6, this will be for 36 months with the possibility of rotating to a third grid training centre. Job descriptions for all units included.

Thames Valley	Oncology Thames Valley - Oxford	Oxford Children's Hospital (18 months - Oncology) & one of London, Birmingham or Bristol (6 months - Bone Marrow Transplant/Oncology)	1	Oxford for 18 months with 6 months in one of GOSH, London or Birmingham or Bristol for Bone Marrow Transplant (BMT). The choice of which centre for BMT will be down to the trainee and will therefore be decided once in post in Oxford.
Wales & South West Severn	Oncology Wales & South West Severn - Cardiff & Bristol	Noah's Ark Children's Hospital for Wales, Cardiff (18 months) Bristol Royal Hospital for Children (6 months - Bone Marrow Transplant)	1	This is a 2-year GRID programme leading to a CCT in Paediatric Oncology. The programme is designed to enable you to complete the specialty curriculum. The majority of the training will be in the paediatric oncology/haematology department within the Children's Hospital for Wales (18 months) where there are excellent links with all the subspecialty teams and the Teenage Cancer unit. There will be a 6-month placement in Bristol Royal Hospital for Children for training in bone marrow transplant. The timing of this will be tailored to fit training needs of all trainees in the two sites. You will remain a Welsh trainee throughout, and HEIW will be responsible for your training and ARCP. Wales is a great place to live and train. With easy access to the sea and mountains, plus a proud cultural heritage it offers a great deal for a small country and an excellent quality of life.

NB. There will be a SharePoint folder for each sub-specialty and region. The post title also refers to the offer code in Oriel.
