- If you are a Health Board/Trust designated lead, we have made your account for you.
 - If you have not been active on the Epilepsy12 platform within the past year, we did not migrate your account to the new platform.

 - When your account is made, you will receive an email with a link to set your password. This link expires after 72 hours

Logging in

- Access the platform here - <https://e12.rcpch.ac.uk/>
- Click the sign-in button at the top right of the screen 
- Enter your email, password, and complete the captcha.
- Enter your two factor authentication token. If it's your first time logging in, you will need to set up two factor authentication.

- You have two options when setting up two factor authentication
- 1. Email - an email will be sent to you with a six digit code.
- 2. Authenticator app – the app will provide a six digit code that refreshes every 30 seconds.

- To set up the authenticator app, follow the below guidance that appears on your screen. It will look like this:

Complete the following steps to configure your mobile app.

1. Install the Microsoft authenticator app for Windows Phone, Android or iOS.
2. In the app, add an account and choose "Work or school account".
3. Scan the image below.
