

Actions when admitting a child with suspected clade I (HCID) mpox (monkeypox)

Task	Mark when completed
Allocate cubicle with <i>en suite</i> toilet or commode (negative pressure if available, otherwise neutral pressure – do not admit to a positive pressure cubicle)	<input type="checkbox"/>
Inform IPC team and plan waste disposal	<input type="checkbox"/>
Put up signage about “No entry” and the need for appropriate PPE	<input type="checkbox"/>
Ensure supply of PPE available	<input type="checkbox"/>
Start a log of entry/exit to the room including reason for entry	<input type="checkbox"/>
Inform paediatric consultant	<input type="checkbox"/>
Discuss with regional paediatric infectious disease	<input type="checkbox"/>
Inform microbiology/virology and Imported Fever Service to plan testing	<input type="checkbox"/>
