OUR OBJECTIVES

Our objective for the year is to:

- 1. Celebrate how far we've come: Since we started in 2015, over 16,000 children, young people and family members volunteered thousands hours on projects and activities looking at experiences with long term conditions such as epilepsy or health policy areas like indoor air quality, even reviewing evidence and writing their own recommendations and responses on topics like COVID-19, on what keeps children and young people healthy, happy or well or their needs for the work force of the future we are celebrating the rich engagement over the last 10 years.
- 2. Sustain improvement to health services for children and young people: While expressing commitment to RCPCH &Us is commendable, it's crucial to actively involve children and young



people with health conditions, along with their peers, in service improvement, design, and system change within the NHS. This should be done through an embedded, rights-based approach. We encourage the health sector to adopt this practice. Explore our Engagement Standards project, which raises awareness of good engagement practices in the sector, and our Engagement Academy, which offers the necessary training to effectively implement these practices.

3. Unlock the next decade of RCPCH &Us: We want to ensure health systems are aware of their role and as duty bearers, to support children and young people across the country to have access to health services and that systems meets their needs, by children and young people and their advocates to be equipped and enable to challenge, shape and change healthcare for generations to come.
