Facing the Future – Using Data to Support Transformation in Scotland

Aims and Objectives: We all recognise a need to transform inpatient health services for

children. But where do we start? The first objective of this talk is to describe what the expectations of parents and staff are, and how these are mostly similar. The second objective is to present relevant results from the FLAMINGO study; this study linked up routinely acquired healthcare data before and after a paediatric admission. And the third objective is to describe the impact of data from Scotland which indicate how we might successfully transform business as usual and take some of the friction out of the NHS in

Scotland (and elsewhere).
