

# Diabetes at School PREM 2026: Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

- 1.** Any child or young person entering the draw must be currently attending a Paediatric Diabetes Unit in England, Wales or Jersey.
- 2.** Any parent or carer entering the draw must have a child who is currently attending a Paediatric Diabetes Unit in England, Wales or Jersey.
- 3.** Any child or young person participating must be below the age of 25 years to enter the draw.
- 4.** Any child or young person entering the draw who is below the age of 16 years must provide their parent or caregiver's contact details and must have their consent to enter the draw.
- 5.** The draw is not open to any child or immediate family of a staff member of the Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health.
- 6.** Only one entry is allowed per child/young person or parent/carer.
- 7.** Entry into the draw will remain open as long as the PREM survey is live online. Winners will be chosen within a month of it closing.
- 8.** Two winners will be selected for the prize of a £50 One4all eGift voucher, one of whom is a parent or carer, the other being a child or young person.
- 9.** The winners will be selected at random.
- 10.** If a chosen winner does not respond to correspondence within two weeks, a new winner will be selected.
- 11.** All decisions will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 12.** The prize will not be transferable to another person.
- 13.** The prize cannot be exchanged for cash or any other prize.
- 14.** The prize will be sent from a staff member of the Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health and not by a third party.
- 15.** All information that is collected from participants will be permanently deleted within a week of the prize being transferred to the selected winner.
