Context	You are a newly appointed consultant
Task	Read the information below. The assessor will discuss aspects of this scenario with you.
Information for trainee	<p>Jade is a 13 year old girl and was admitted overnight having taken an overdose of her mother's fluoxetine. She has no previous medical history of note. Menarche was at 12 years of age. On examination, she has a heart rate 80 beats per min, blood pressure 100/50 mmHg, respiratory rate 20/min and SaO2 96% on air. Her electrolytes were within normal range.</p> <p>She refused to discuss the reason for the overdose in accident and emergency. However, she has revealed to the nurse looking after her overnight that she took the overdose as she thinks that she is pregnant. She is "very scared" of how her mother may respond to this. Her mother is not aware of her admission and Jade has requested that her mother is not contacted. The overnight nurse has managed to find out that she has had a boyfriend for the past year and he is over 20 years of age.</p> <p>When you see her in the ward round, she is very tearful and again asks you not to tell her mother or her boyfriend as she is worried that they will be very angry with her.</p>
