

INFORMATION FOR TRAINEE

Context	You are a newly appointed consultant
Task	Discuss your management plan with the assessor.
Information for trainee	You are a consultant paediatrician performing an outpatient clinic. One of your teenage patients, whom you see regarding his asthma, tells you that his hand is still swollen and sore following an accident one week ago. You discover from his case notes that he attended the Emergency Department after his accident, that his hand was x-rayed and that this was reported by the junior doctor in ED as being normal; he was sent home with analgesia and no follow-up. On checking his formal x-ray report, however, you find that the radiologist reported the presence of a fracture.

You are the parent of a 10 year old boy with asthma. You have come to outpatients for review of his asthma with the paediatrician. Last week your son injured his hand and, on visiting your local ED, you were told that the x-ray was clear, you were reassured and sent home with no follow-up. You have mentioned to the doctor today that your son's hand still hurts, is swollen and painful to move.
